**What if I lost the homework?** First, figure out how to get organized. Then, go to <u>pantherpage.wordpress.com</u> and print out a new copy of the homework.

What if I don't want to do the homework? Too bad. This homework was carefully designed by your future teacher and your work ethic is a reflection of your character. Everyone has to do things they don't necessarily want to do (does everyone want to get out of bed and go to work? Not always, but they do it anyway and then they get their paycheck.
