Do I complete all 8 assignments?

No. You only need to complete all three of the main dishes. You should complete two out of the three side dishes. And you can do the dessert activities for extra points but you don't have to.

Some of the assignments say to write an argument. What if I don't know how to write one?

Use the example response on the back to get more of an idea of how to write it. Then give it your best shot. It's better to try than to complete nothing. Also, feel free to e-mail drafts to Ms. Tenorio at stenorio@goldercollegeprep.org if you would like some feedback before you turn it in.

What is textual evidence?

Textual evidence is a direct sentence or sentences, taken from the book and used to defend your argument.

Do I need to annotate the book?

No.
